Old Testament

Leviticus 26:12

I will be with you; I will be your God, and you will be my people.

Numbers 6:24-26

May the Lord bless you and take care of you;
May the Lord be kind and gracious to you;
May the Lord look on you with favor and give you peace.

Deuteronomy 4:29

You will look for the Lord your God,
and if you search for him with all your heart, you will find him.

Ruth 1:16

Ruth said, "Don't ask me to leave you! Let me go with you.
Wherever you go, I will go; wherever you live, I will live.
Your people will be my people, and your God will be my God.

II Samuel 22:31

This God -- how perfect are his deeds, how dependable are his words! He is like a shield for all who seek his protection.

I Kings 8:56

"Praise the Lord who has given his people peace,
as he promised he would.

I Chronicles 16:8-10

I Timothy 6:12

II Timothy 2:1

Titus 2:13-14

and to make us a pure people who belong to him alone

Hebrews 13:8
