BIG KID CONFIRMATION: **Wednesdays | 6:30 p.m. | Living Room New book discussion begins this Wednesday, Jan. 25**

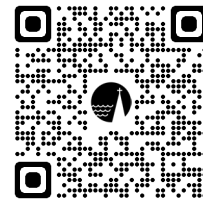
