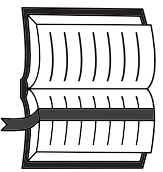
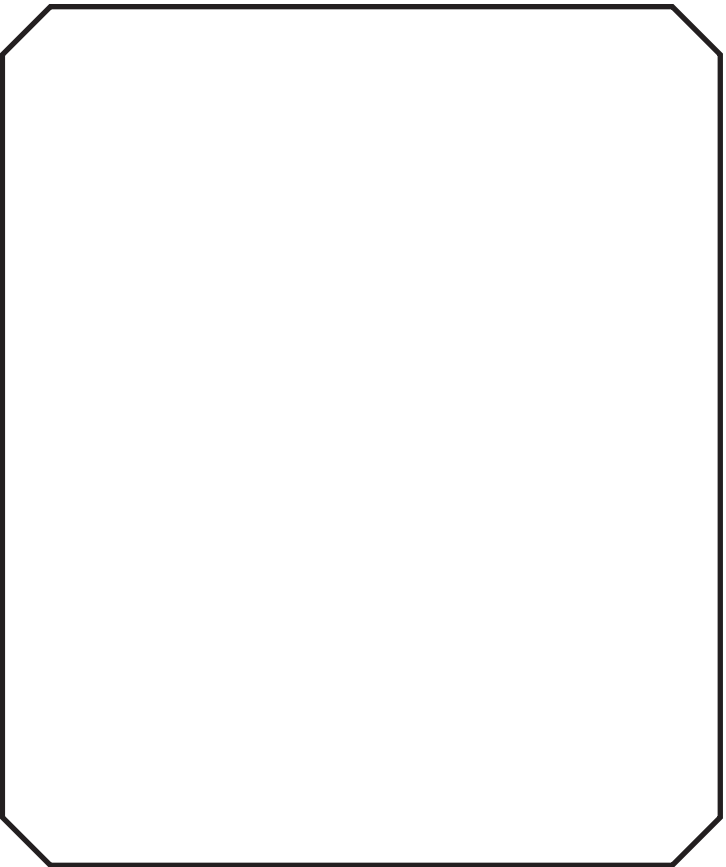


DRAW IT

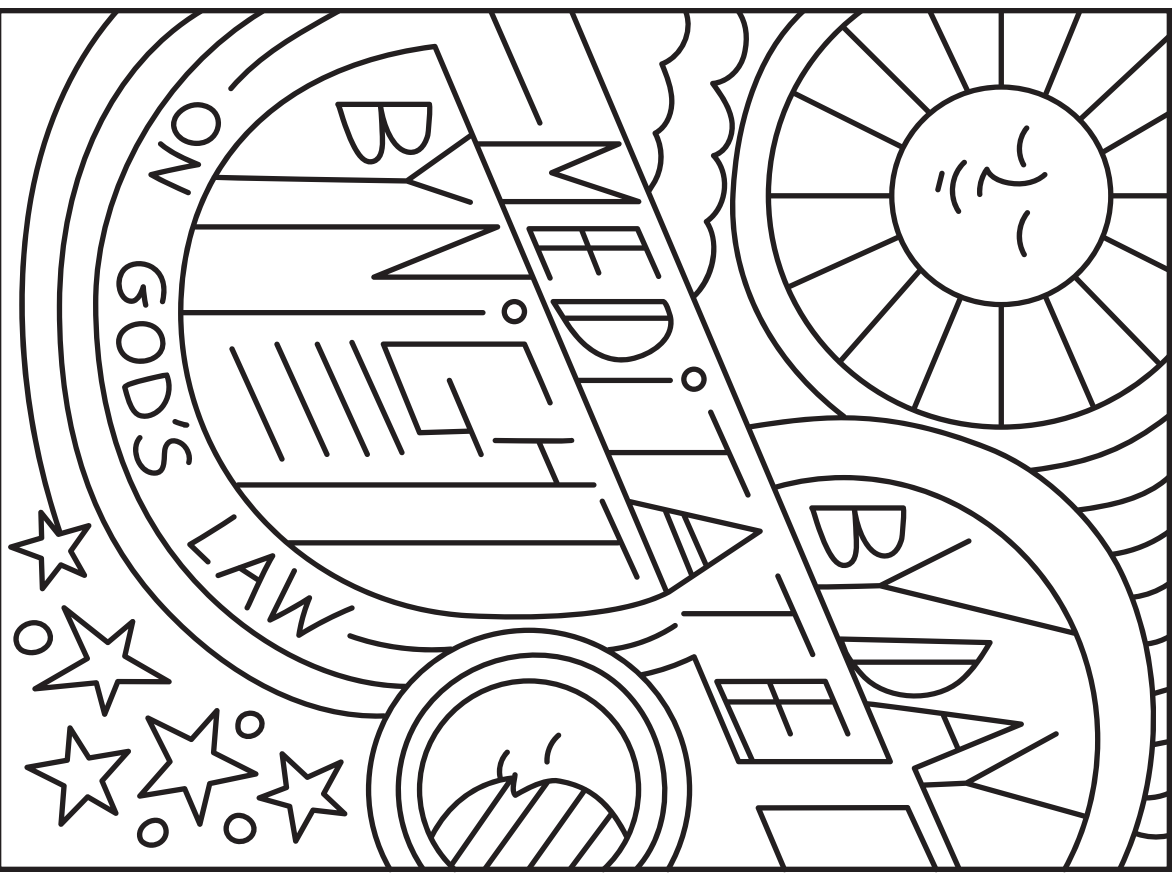

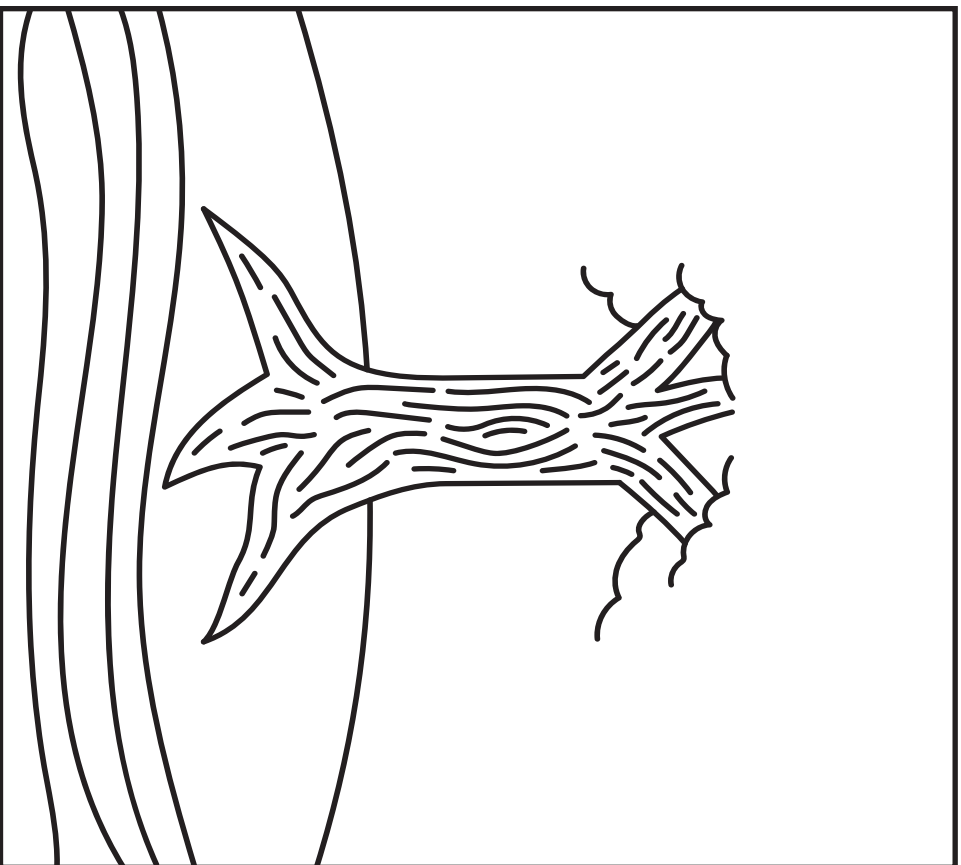
CHILDREN'S WORSHIP • BULLETIN

Activities based on Psalm 1, Acts 1:15-17, 2:1-26, John 17:6-19.



FINISH the DRAWING

Psalm 1 says that those who love and follow God are like trees planted by water. They have everything they need, and they bloom with lots of fruit because they are connected with their life-source - GOD! Finish drawing the tree and draw or write within it some good things that come from following God (examples: peaceful heart, joy, wisdom in decisions, use your imagination!).
